With your sincere and timely support we were able to complete our New Medical Ward and ICU. There was a bit of delay because of the rains and also in procuring the equipment for the ICU. However, now it has become functional and is already making a difference in the quality of care here. The difference it has made

1. A New spacious Medical Ward with 13 beds
2. A full fledged 2 bed ICU with Ventilatory support and up to date monitoring devices.
3. An isolation room with 2 beds for burns, open TB and HIV patients
4. A large training and meeting hall – can seat 150 – 200 people
5. Administrative space which is well lit and spacious.

A few photographs are attached for you to get a feeling of the change you have made in this remote tribal area. You will always be a good friend of Sittilingi and i pass on the gratitude of the tribals to you.
